COSTS (Pool membership separate. See pool office for forms)

Registration: 1st child: \$60, 2nd child: \$50, additional children: \$40 each.

Team swimsuits are available at the beginning of the season. Goggles and caps are recommended and available at most sporting goods stores.

Prince-Mont Swim League requires that swim team members must be registered members of the sponsoring pool.

SCHEDULE (Get copy of 2010 BSTA Pool and Swim Team Calendar)

Practice Schedule: Practices are scheduled Monday through Friday evenings from 7-9 p.m. with morning practices beginning June 14th from 7-9 a.m. Baseline times for each swimmer will be taken during the first 2 weeks of practice. Swim team members are required to attend 4-5 practices per week to properly prepare for participation in meets. **The swim team practice area is for coaches and swim team only.** All parents, patrons, and guests will need to be respectful and remain clear. There will be time following practice for parents to talk with the coaches.

Meet Schedule: There will be 5 dual meets beginning June 19. Divisionals meet is July 24 at PGP and the All-Stars meet is July 31. Details are on the PMSL website <http://www.princemont.org>

HOW YOU CAN HELP (Sign up on volunteer sheet)

Blue Wave requests a minimum of 20 service hours from each family for the following 2 categories:

- **Officials:** Each meet requires around 30 officials from each team. Timers, referees, stroke and turn judges, scorer, clerk of course, starters, etc. Some of these positions require training. Therefore, please plan to attend the PMSL Officials' Training on Saturday, June 12 from 5:30 – 8:30 p.m. Location is University of Maryland Armory (see directions below). Those interested please meet at the pool to caravan.
- **Fundraisers/Sponsorships:** Operating costs for this season are projected to be ~ \$12,000. Therefore, we ask each family to support our fundraisers. Currently, our fundraisers are meet concessions and raffles, the lapathon, and support of various local sponsors. Bring your ideas.

DIRECTIONS:

6/12/2010. PMSL Clinic @ University of Maryland Armory: Take the College Park/US-1 Exit (Exit #25) from I95/I495. Go south on US-1 for about 2 miles to the campus. Follow the map below to get to the Armory. Park in Lots C1 or C2.

6/19/2010. HCC (Hawthorn Country Club) RT. 225, La Plata, MD 20646, (301) 934-9808: From Capital Beltway to Rt. 5 (Branch Ave.) South. Rt. 5 becomes Rt. 301, continue South to La Plata. Turn R at Rt. 225, pool is on R about 1 1/4 miles.

6/26/2010. AST (Accokeek Swim Team) 2311 Bryan Point Road, Accokeek, MD 20607, (301) 292-6321: From Beltway (I-95), take exit 3 - Route 210 South. Follow Rt. 210 for approx. 8 miles. Turn right at light at intersection of Livingston Road and Rt. 373 on to Livingston Road (B & J Carryout on Right). Go one block and turn right on Biddle Rd. Go one block and turn left on Bryan Point Road. Moyaone Pool is 2.5 miles on the right past the beige cottage.

7/24/2010. PGP (Prince George's Pool) 3400 Buchanan Street, Mt. Rainier, MD 20712, (301) 277-8896: From Capital Beltway, take Route 1 South toward College Park. Follow for about 7 miles to Mt. Rainier. Turn R on 34th Street. Follow through 2 traffic lights (about 1 mile). Take next L onto Buchanan Street. Pool parking lot is on left.
